



THINK, LEAD AND INFLUENCE STRATEGICALLY

Program Overview

In a virtual work environment – especially during times of crisis – it can be easy to lose sight of the big picture. Leaders must now reconcile both the needs of daily work and the ability to think on a broad scale. Everyday thinking, acting, and influencing is different from strategic thinking, strategic acting, and strategic influencing. Using that knowledge, participants will practice activating their strategic capability. This 9 hour program is delivered over 3 consecutive days (3 hours per day).

Key Objectives:

- Learn how everyday thinking, acting and influencing gets you everyday results, and activating strategic thinking, acting and influencing gives you **competitive breakthroughs**
- Explore the methods and practices needed to remain strategic in your thinking, acting and influencing in the face of great complexity and unexpected demands
- More effectively manage your own response to crises/unexpected events by better understanding how your brain responds to crisis and the impact it has on your leadership choices
- Establish key actions that will allow you to **confidently step into challenges and ambiguity** and remain strategic in your thinking, acting and influencing
