

Sparking up your innovation

Overview

This three-day course focuses on personality and creativity, supporting you to understand more about yourself, both as an individual and as an innovator within your working environment. The course will require you to step outside of your comfort zone as you reflect and learn and will encourage you to take on new techniques to develop your own approach to innovation. It will also enable you to better support those around you to also become true innovators.

The learning style of the course is highly collaborative. It will take you on a shared learning journey where you will not only gain valuable understanding from our expert creativity facilitators but will also learn from and support your fellow participants. Each day is highly interactive, requiring active participation, sharing of insights, and the need for you to truly immerse yourself in the experience. While the first two days are focused on your learning, the final day will enable you to recognise how the innovation techniques you learn can be taken away from the classroom and implemented in your working life.

The programme focuses on:

- Enhancing self-knowledge
- Valuing diversity
- Leading from the front - encouraging others to innovate
- "Parallel thinking" for problem solving
- Strategies to enhance decision making



Objective

The core objective of the course is to help you recognise and appreciate the practical application of personal innovation to be applied in organisational settings.

At the end of the programme, you will leave with a simple action plan to boost your personal creativity and an enhanced capacity to empower others to innovate.

In a nutshell, you will become a master of proficiency for innovation techniques.

This course is designed to be inclusive and relevant to individuals working at all levels of the organisation.

It is also intended to support any professional across a breadth of industry sectors.

- Individuals who personally need to innovate
- Individuals who lead and manage others who need to innovate

- Engage and work with strategies for encouraging innovation in yourself and others
- Learn new processes to assist with developing skills across the whole innovation journey
- Appreciate that innovation is more than just having ideas; the implementation processes that accompany creative innovations are fundamental to success
